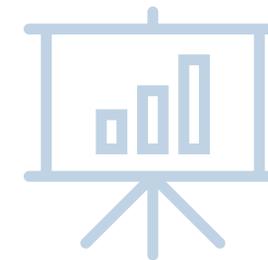










# Age of Inbound Tourists





Number of Student Weeks


